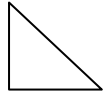


Paper Cutouts

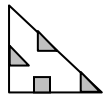
Paper Snowflake



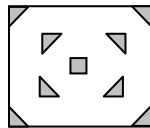
Start with a square or circular piece of paper.



Fold it into quarters, eighths, or any which way.



Cut out little shapes from any edges as you like. Be sure to cut through all the layers.



Open the paper to see the snowflake.

Paper Dolls



Start with a piece of paper about 4 to 6 inches high (the height the dolls will be), and as long as you like.



Accordion-fold (pleat) the paper. The pleats should all be the same size, about 2 to 3 inches wide. (Side view shown.)

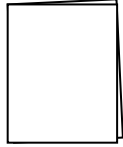


Cutting through all the layers, cut away the parts that aren't a doll. Leave parts on the edges so the dolls will connect.

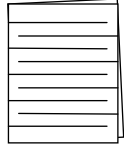


Spread them out to see how they look.

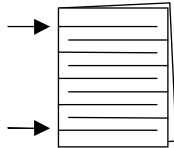
Walking Through a File Card



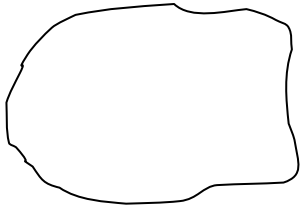
Fold the file card in half.



Slice as shown (through both layers).
Leave about ¼” on the sides – don’t slice
all the way across. Start and end on the
spine side.



Slice open the spine (between the
arrows).



Gently open the chain.

To get a bigger chain, use a bigger card,
or make more slices very close together.
